This is managed by processing and recycling waste into products that can be used in a wide cross section of industrial, domestic and leisure purposes.

We offer a complete waste management package which is supported by a fully auditable administration system.

Our experience in waste management services is extensive with services ranging from:

All of the above services are based at our two fully licensed transfer stations at Ilkeston and Swadlincote.

The Ward Recycling Transfer Station provides a Sorting and Segregation process on behalf of our customers presenting mixed waste load.

Timber, ferrous and non-ferrous metals, paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and construction waste including plaster board are catered for on site.

We operate a Redox Reducing operation which enables us to achieve 85% recycling target.

Ward Recycling continues to operate an innovative waste management policy which maximises the re-use and recovery of materials whilst carrying out landfill as a last resort.

From the moment you ask Ward Recycling to look at your waste management strategy, we will take a step by step look at your current process to determine the most beneficial and cost effective means of managing your waste.

Ward Recycling has developed the following steps to provide a full assessment of your waste streams:

Initial Assessment

We will complete an assessment of your current process, identifying areas that can be improved. We audit all of your waste streams including hazardous materials. The audit also contains the following key areas:

- Volumes
- Costings
- Recycling Targets
- Current on site equipment
- Re-occurring problems

Process and Management

After we have completed our detailed assessment we produce a proposal detailing all of the following key areas:

- **Costings** - identifying the most cost effective means of managing your waste, this includes the introduction of any recycling equipment that can help reduce costings.

- **Managed Waste Systems** - Ward Recycling will develop a workable, manageable and achievable waste system which includes any waste storage or waste reduction systems.

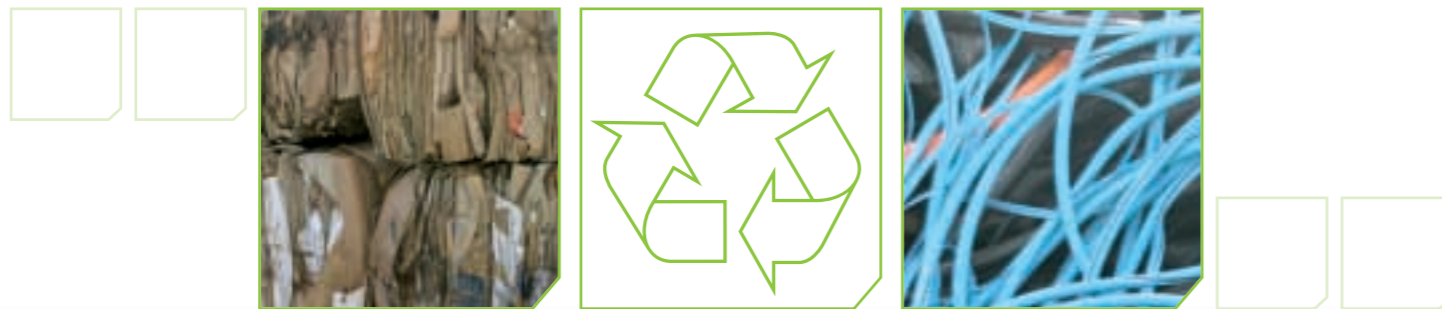
Actioning
